To the FCC Commissioners:

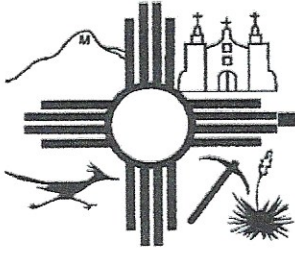
